An E-Learning day occurs when weather conditions, mechanical failure, etc. makes in-person learning impossible.



Emergency Closing Information:

If an E-Learning day is necessary, the Superintendent will communicate this as early as possible but *no later than 10 p.m. the night prior* to the E-Learning day.
