# 2023 SUMMER SCHOOL DRIVERS' EDUCATION

Community High School District 94 will offer a summer Driver Education Program **beginning Wednesday**, **May 31st 2023** and **ending Wednesday**, **June 21nd 2023**. Classes will meet Monday – Friday each week, times will alternate every day. Students will be informed of their class and BTW times during the May sessions, but all times will be between 8:00am-12:00pm.

#### **REGISTRATION**:

The registration form for summer school is enclosed. Registration is now open. The student or parent must *turn in applications to Mrs. Cuautle in person, in the Student Activity Center* before or after school or during the student's lunch hour. Please *do not* mail the application or give it to any other staff member. Applications will be due Friday, May 5th.

Students must be fifteen years old by May 31st, 2023 to obtain his/her Learners Permit. Fourteen year olds may take the classroom portion of Drivers Ed, but cannot get his/her permit until turning fifteen. Each student must live in district and complete the Learners' Permit classes on May 9th and 10th 2023 detailed in this mailing. Students who do not complete the May portion of this process or who do not have a permit may still take the classroom portion of Drivers Ed, but will be ineligible for Behind-The-Wheel lessons. If a student already has a permit he/she is not required to attend the May session. Students must also meet the State requirement of passing eight (8) classes prior to Driver's Education starting.

#### FEES:

The fees for summer school are \$50 for SE-10 classroom and \$300 for BTW (\$350 for both classroom and BTW). The fee is due upon registration. Checks must be made payable to <u>West Chicago Community High</u> <u>School.</u> This check is non-refundable once the student begins the class.

There is a \$20.00 fee to obtain the student's Learners' Permit. NO CASH! This check will be due during the May Learners' Permit classes. Checks made payable to the <u>*"IL-SOS"*</u>.

#### ATTENDANCE:

Classroom and BTW are considered two different courses. The absence policy will be the same for each. One (1) absence will be permitted from each classroom and BTW. Upon the second absence, your student will be dropped from the classroom or BTW program, whichever class they missed. <u>THERE WILL</u> <u>BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY</u>, this is a State of Illinois policy. Please keep this in mind when planning a family vacation or summer camps for your student.

# **Getting ready for Summer School**

1. You must register <u>IN PERSON</u> with Mrs. Cuautle either before or after school in **the Student** Activity Center.

2. You can get a copy of "*Rules of the Road*" upon registration or online at: <u>https://www.ilsos.gov/publications/pdf\_publications/dsd\_a112.pdf</u>. You will need to have this read and understood prior to Tuesday, May 9th.

3. For the May permit session, meet in Room 2544 before school (7:00-7:45 a.m.) or after school (3:15 - 4:00 p.m.) on the dates noted below.

4. By Wednesday, May 10, you'll need to bring a check for your Learners' Permit. The cost is \$20 and the check should be made out to "**IL-SOS**." *NO CASH.*

#### **Summer School Notes:**

- Dates for Summer School: Wednesday, May 31st 2023 and ending Wednesday, June 21st 2023.
- Classes will meet Monday Friday each week, times will alternate every day. Students will be informed of their class and BTW times during the May Permit Session, but all times will be between 8:00am-12:00pm.
- Use Entrance "B" during Summer School.

#### **Attendance Policies:**

- The student will be dropped from the classroom phase <u>on the second absence</u> from class.
- The student will be dropped from the BTW phase on the second absence from BTW.
- There are <u>NO</u> exceptions to this drop rule. Please schedule vacations, camps, outings, etc. around this schedule.
