Course Objectives

Students will learn to...

Independently **conceptualize**, **organize**, **refine and complete** artistic ideas and work.

Synthesize and relate knowledge and personal experiences to create artwork.

Develop and refine artistic work for presentation, and **convey meaning** through the presentation of artistic work.

Perceive and analyze artistic work, interpret intent and meaning in artistic work, and **apply criteria to evaluate artistic work** – their own and that of others.

Relate artistic ideas and works with its context to **deepen understanding**.

Refine proficiency with the tools, techniques, and stages of clay.

Course Details

The Advanced Ceramics course allows an advanced ceramics student to pursue independent projects under the guidance of the teacher. We will all begin the semester with the creation of an Image Bank, and Sketch Journal and digital portfolio. Students will use these resources as a place to get inspired, sketch out ideas for projects and record the progress of your work through the semester.

All advanced students will be given broad topics to inspire their work and help focus their production. At the end of the semester, they will have a **body of sophisticated pieces** that **demonstrate their own artistic growth and skill**.

Students will plan, design and produce original ceramic work. Assessment will be done on work in progress, finished work and the entire body of work created in a semester.

Students will be given **reading and reflecting** assignments to deepen their understanding of, and connection to the world of ceramics.

Participation is an important part of this class and is made up of the following: promptness to class, preparedness, respect, Camera On (Virtual), positive interaction, and daily work. Since we are working with the expression of our own ideas and opinions, some of which can be very personal, having a positive community atmosphere in an art classroom is vitally important. Also, due to various safety and health concerns, it is very important to keep your work space clean.

R – Respect everyone and everything (Teacher, Classmates, Supplies, Art Work & Technology Rules)


T – Think about ART: Understand, Demonstrate & Reflect.
