Course Objectives

Students will learn to...

Independently conceptualize, organize, refine and complete artistic ideas and work.

Synthesize and relate knowledge and personal experiences to create graphic artwork.

Develop and refine artistic work for presentation, and **convey meaning** through the presentation of artistic work.

Perceive and analyze artistic work, interpret intent and meaning in artistic work, and **apply criteria to evaluate artistic work** – their own and that of others.

Relate artistic ideas and works with its context to **deepen understanding**.

Refine proficiency with the programs, techniques, and areas of Graphic Art.

Course Details

The Advanced Graphic Art course allows an advanced graphic art student to pursue independent projects under the guidance of the teacher.

All advanced students will be given broad topics to inspire their work and help focus their production. Students will choose where they want to focus their creativity and skill development. They can use Adobe Photoshop or Illustrator to create works of Graphic Design or Graphic Art. Through it all, students will plan, design and produce original work. At the end of the semester, they will have a body of sophisticated pieces that demonstrate their own artistic growth and skill.

Assessment will be done on work in progress, finished work and the entire body of work created in a semester. Projects will be graded for Creativity, Composition, and Technical Skill.

Students will be given **reading and reflecting** assignments to deepen their understanding of, and connection to the world of graphic art.

Participation is an important part of this class and is made up of the following: promptness to class, preparedness, respect, positive interaction, and daily work. Since we are working with the expression of our own ideas and opinions, some of which can be very personal, having a positive community atmosphere in an art classroom is vitally important.

And remember... due to the fact that this class requires very specific computer programs that most don't have at home, please be prepared for class and use your class time well.

A – Attitude (Artitude) Come in ready to work! ☺


R – Respect everyone and everything (Teacher, Classmates, Supplies, Art Work & Technology Rules)
