Course Objectives

Students will learn to...

Generate, develop and refine **artistic ideas** and work using some of the classic ceramic techniques.

Synthesize and relate knowledge and personal experiences to **create artwork**.

Perceive and analyze artistic work and apply criteria to **evaluate artistic work** – their own and that of others.

Understand the tools, processes and materials to make more informed, successful decisions when creating ceramics work.

Appreciate the history of and technical processes of clay.

Course Details

We will create several pieces over the course of the semester. Each project will teach you new and more complex skills and concepts. Each project will be assessed on the following: Creativity & Conceptual Skills, Technical Skill & Construction, and Glazing.

Along with your clay work, you will also be asked to **complete various written assignments** including: Self-Evaluations, sketches, ArtTalks, student critiques.

Participation is an important part of this class and is made up of the following: promptness to class, preparedness, respect, positive interaction, and daily work. Since we are working with the expression of our own ideas and opinions, some of which can be very personal, having a positive community atmosphere in an art classroom is vitally important. Also, due to various safety and health concerns, it is very important to keep your work space clean.

There will be a **final** for class, which may consist of discussion, writing and possibly presenting.

You **may redo** any assignment if you are not happy with your results. Please talk to me first.

I do offer **Extra Credit** mini projects with each assignment. This will only be accepted on a preapproved basis & IF ALL OTHER WORK IS TURNED IN.

R – Respect everyone and everything (Teacher, Classmates, Supplies, Art Work & Technology Rules)


T – Think about ART: Understand, Demonstrate & Reflect.
