Course Objectives

Students will be able to...

Generate, develop and refine **artistic ideas** and work using a digital camera to take photographs.

Synthesize and relate knowledge and personal experiences to **create photographs**.

Perceive and analyze artistic work and apply criteria to **evaluate photographic work** – their own and that of others.

Understand the parts of the camera and the components that govern exposure to make more informed, successful decisions when taking photographs.

Appreciate the history of and technical processes of photography.

Course Details

We will create LOTS of photographic work over the course of the semester. Each project will teach you new and more complex skills and concepts as you learn to use the DSLR Camera. Each project will be assessed on the following: Creativity, Camera Skills, Photo Editing Skills, and meeting Assignment Requirements.

Along with your Photographic work, you will also be asked to **complete various written assignments** including: Self-Evaluations, quizzes, ArtTalks, critiques.

Participation is an important part of this class and is made up of the following: promptness to class, preparedness, respect, positive interaction, and daily work. Since we are working with the expression of our own ideas and opinions, some of which can be very personal, having a positive community atmosphere in an art classroom is vitally important.

There will be a **final** for class, which may consist of discussion, writing and possibly presenting.

You **may redo** any assignment if you are not happy with your results. Please talk to me first.

I do offer **Extra Credit**. This will only be accepted on a pre-approved basis & IF ALL OTHER WORK IS TURNED IN.

A – Attitude (Artitude) Come in ready to work! ☺


R – Respect everyone and everything (Teacher, Classmates, Supplies, Art Work & Technology Rules)
