# College and Career Pathways



#### Financial Aid

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is an application for college financial aid through grants and loans available to all students.
- FAFSA opens up October 1<sup>st</sup>. WEGO will offer a WORKSHOP for all of our seniors.
- Public Act 101-180 (effective 6/01/20) requires that, beginning with the 2020-2021 school year, public high school students **must complete** the FAFSA or, as eligible, the Alternative Application for Illinois Financial Aid, as a prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma.
- Students can also opt-out by signing a FAFSA waiver form.
