ARTICLE 1. NAME: The name of the Corporation is the Wildcat Booster Club (as amended February 13, 1990 and filed May 21, 1990).

ARTICLE 2. DURATION: The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE 3. ADDRESS: The address of the registered office in the State of Illinois is 326 Joliet Street, West Chicago, IL 60185, County of DuPage, and the name of the Registered Agent is Dr. Douglas Domeracki (as amended and filed August 12, 2013).

ARTICLE 4. PURPOSE: This corporation is formed exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, as specified in section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue code, and exists to promote unity, camaraderie, sportsmanship, and encourage school and community spirit for Community High School District 94 extracurricular activities, and shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)3 (as amended December 5, 2011, and filed December 20, 2011.)

ARTICLE 5. OTHER PROVISIONS: Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes (as amended and filed December 19, 2012).
